

Summer school:

Exploring the marine meiofauna of the Azores – from discovery to scientific publication

When? 15.7.-24.7.19

Where? Universidade dos Açores, Ponta Delgada, São Miguel

Application procedure:

The course is open to 15 graduate students with a strong interest in marine biodiversity and systematics.

How to apply? In the letter of motivation please outline your background in marine biodiversity and systematics, your special interest in meiofauna and how you consider the course beneficial for your career development.

Deadline for application? 15.5.19

All applications will be ranked based on qualification and selected after a joined meeting including all participating scientists. We will aim for an equal gender ratio. The decision will be announced by 31.5.19 via email to the students.

Costs? We are still waiting for the official letter from our funding sources, but we are confident to provide travel grants for all participating students to cover flights, local accommodation (student dorms) and food on course days (university cantina). Final announcement on coverage of costs will be announced latest in the end of April through the website.
